



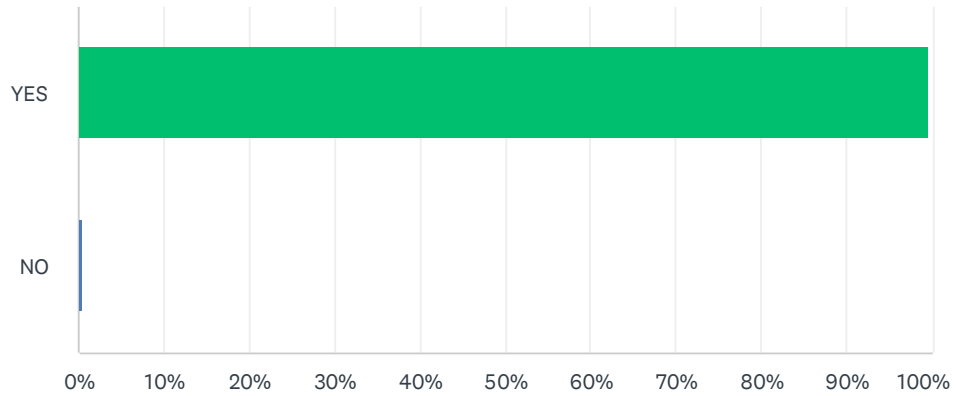
USPPFOP MEMBERSHIP SAFETY SURVEY

March 15, 2022

On March 11, 2022, the Fraternal Order of Police - United States Park Police Labor Committee (USPPFOP) emailed this 16 question survey to the membership regarding Workplace Safety on the United States Park Police. There are 351 dues-paying members of the USPPFOP; 328 dues-paying members are on the email list. The survey was closed at 2400 on March 14, 2022. Out of the 351 dues-payers, we received 249 responses, which means that 70.94% of the members took the survey. The survey has a margin of error of +/- 3%. The survey results are reported in this document.

Q1 Is the USPP dangerously understaffed?

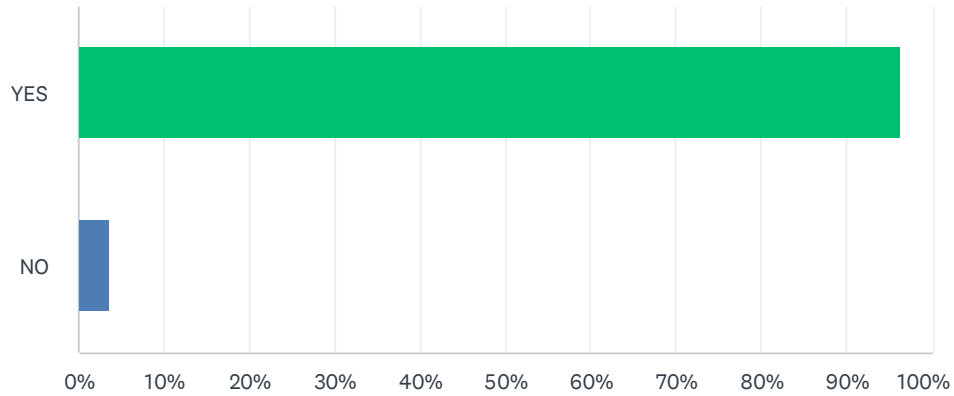

Q2 Was understaffing a factor that caused injuries to officers during the 2020 riots?

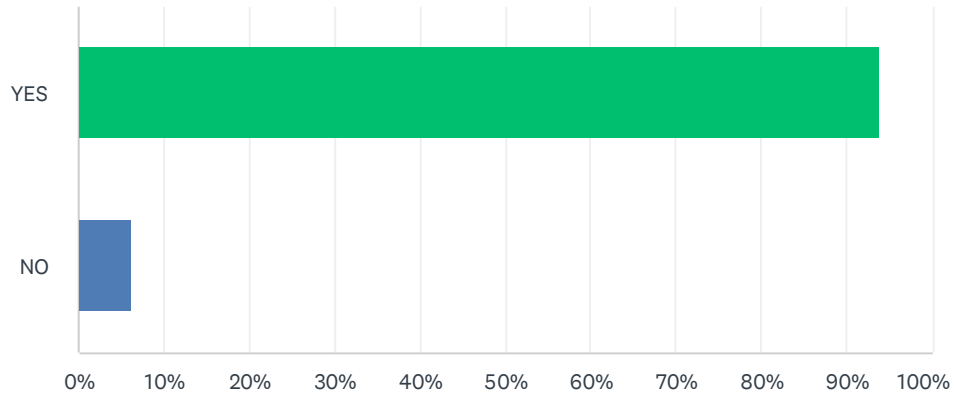

Q3 Was lack of proper gear a factor that caused injuries to officers during the 2020 riots?

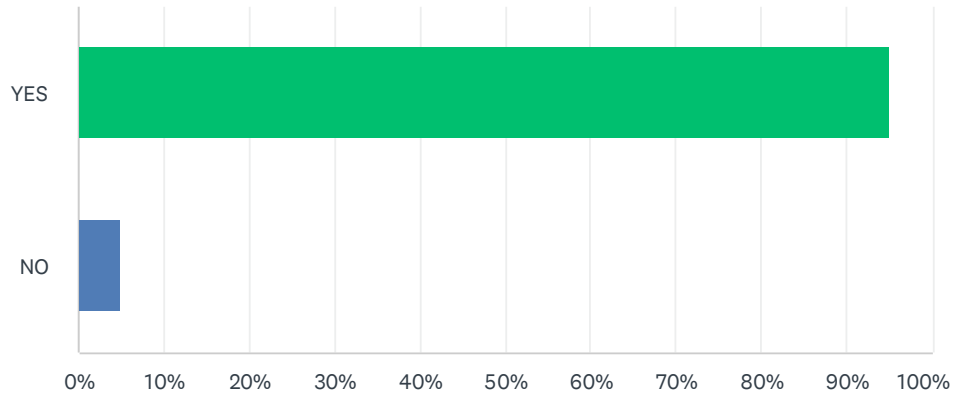

Q4 Did dangerous understaffing prevent the USPP from providing adequate security for the events on January 6, 2021?

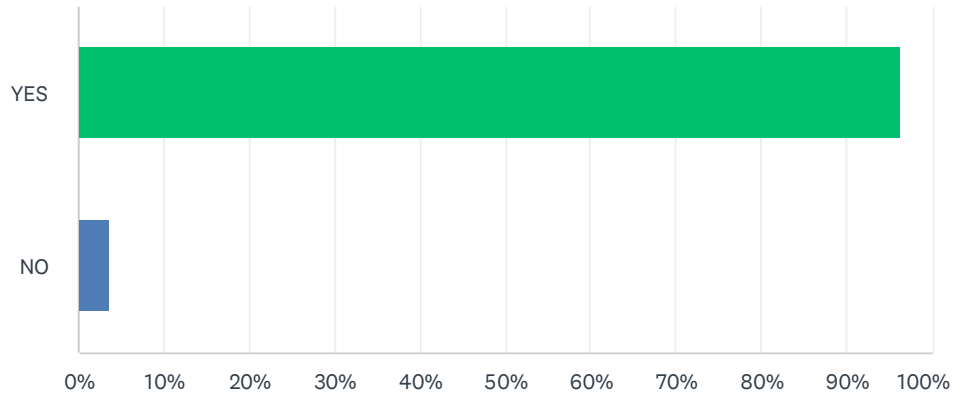

Q5 Would assigning Home-to-Work vehicles to all officers speed the arrival of response forces to critical incidents?

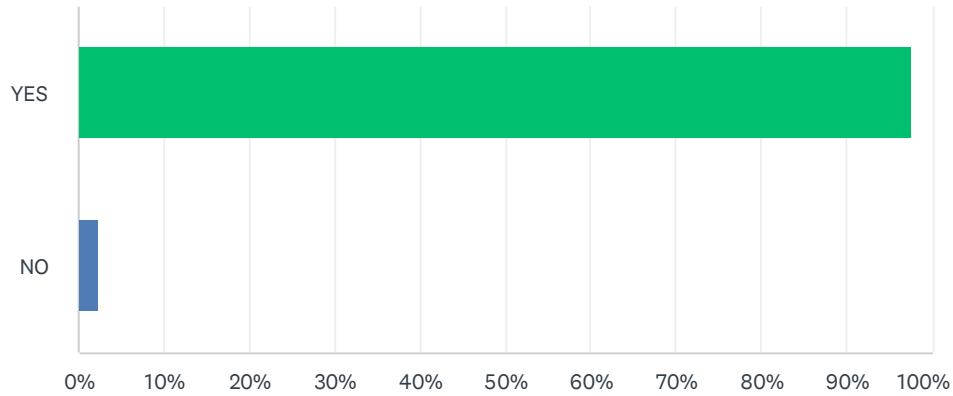

Q6 Would a home-to-work vehicle improve morale, recruitment, and retention?

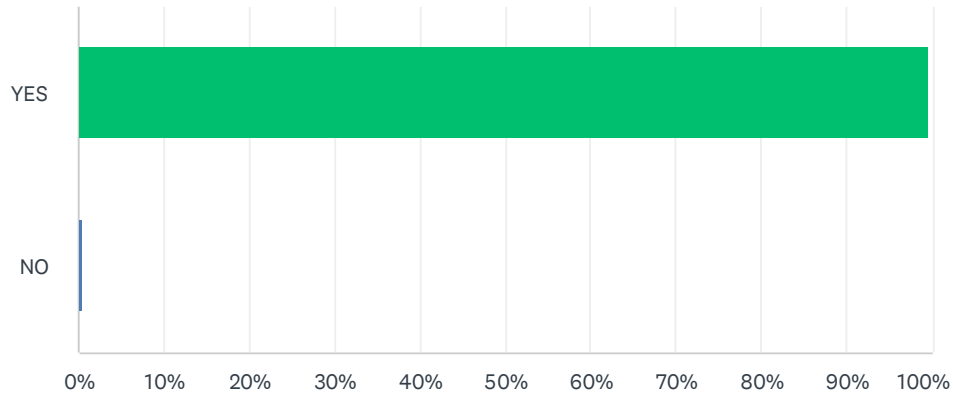

Q7 If H.R. 3924 - The US Park Police Modernization Act (payscale bill) - became law, would morale, recruitment, and retention improve?

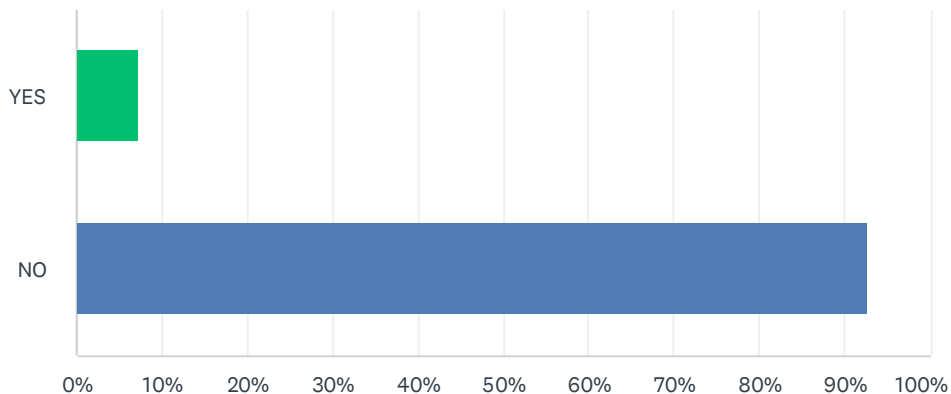

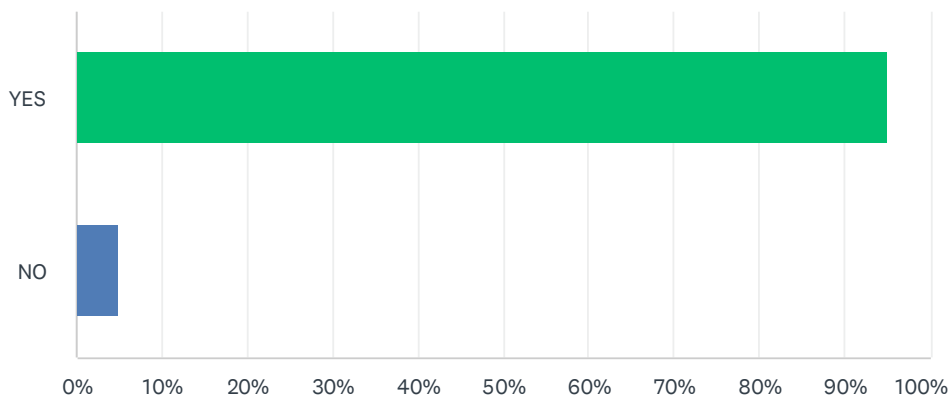

Q9 Do you think USPP Commanders should have been at work participating in carrying out the core mission of the dangerously understaffed force during the pandemic - not teleworking from home?

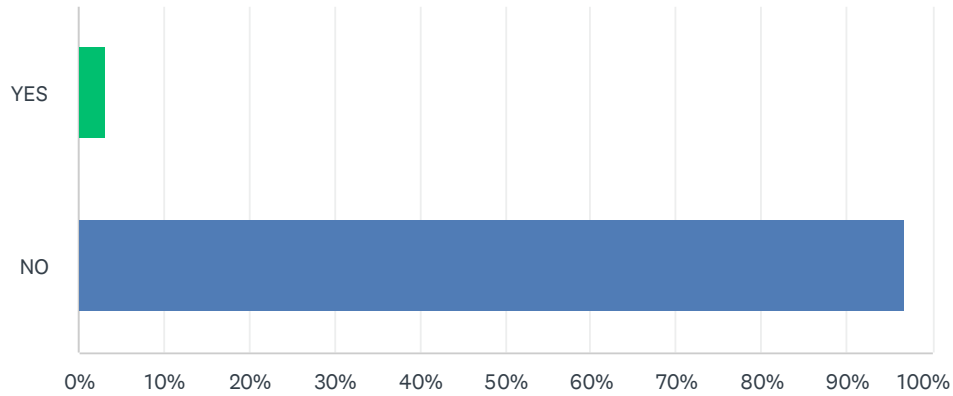

Q10 Do you feel NPS/DOI properly support our mission (funding, staffing, equipment, IT infrastructure, etc)?

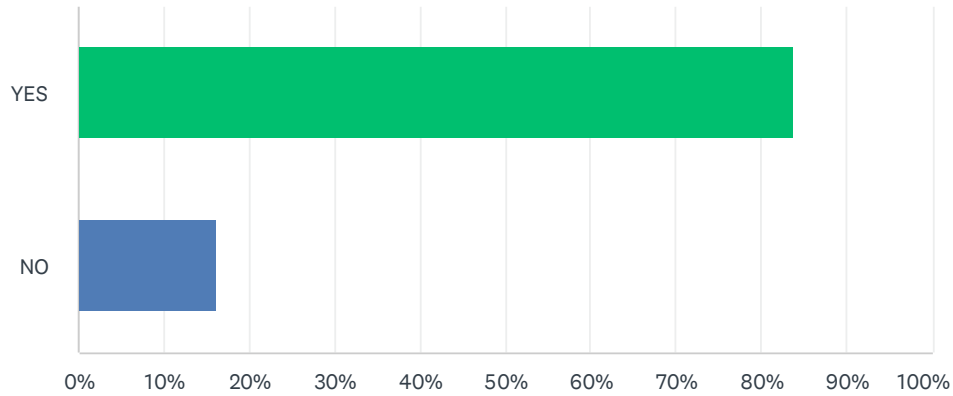

Q11 Do you think actually distributing the USPP's new uniforms would help improve officer productivity, efficiency, safety, and morale?

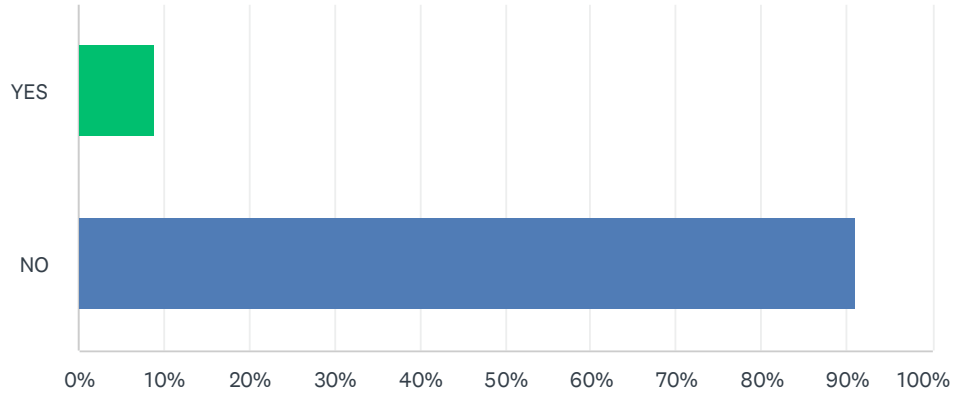

Q12 Do you feel adequately supported by the USPP Executive Command Staff?

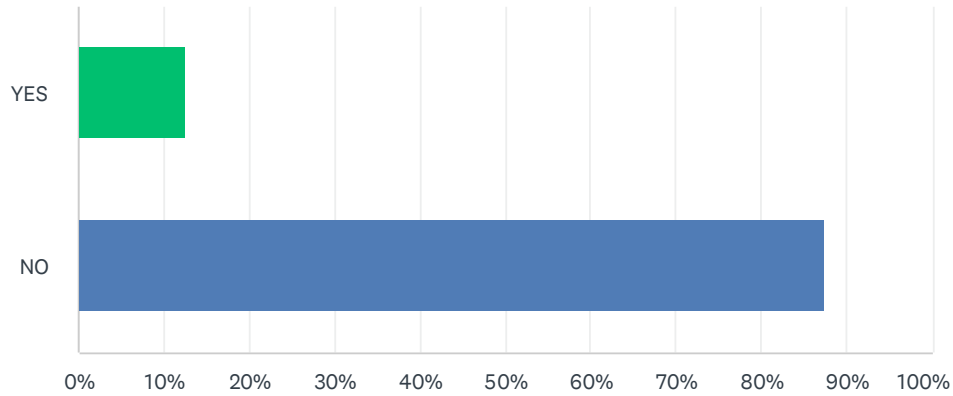

Q13 Does the USPP Executive Command Staff think ensuring your safety and providing a healthful working environment are a high priority?

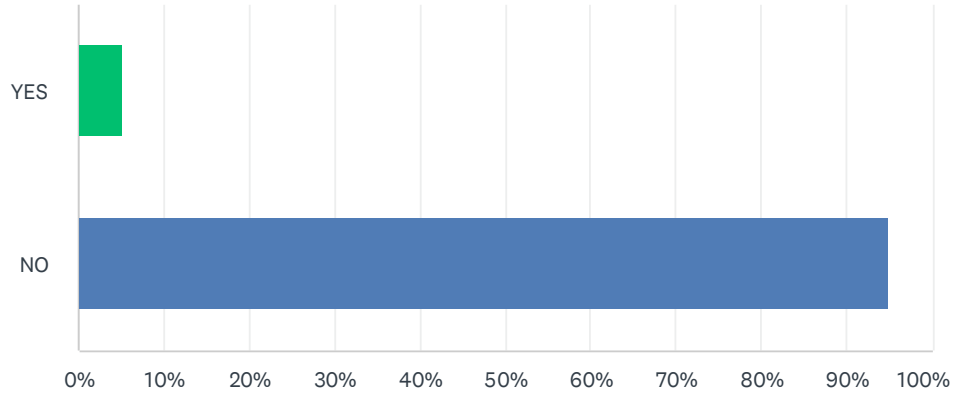

Q14 Does the NPS/DOI care about the safety of your working environment?

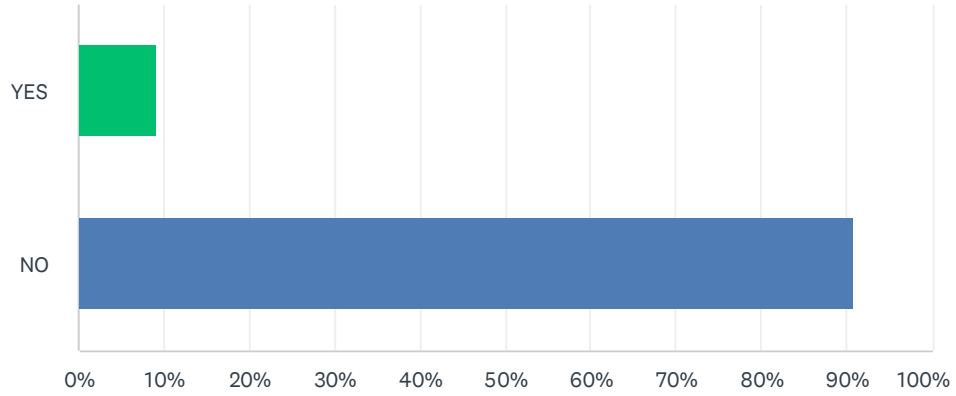

Q15 Do you believe the Executive Command Staff will care about the results of this survey?

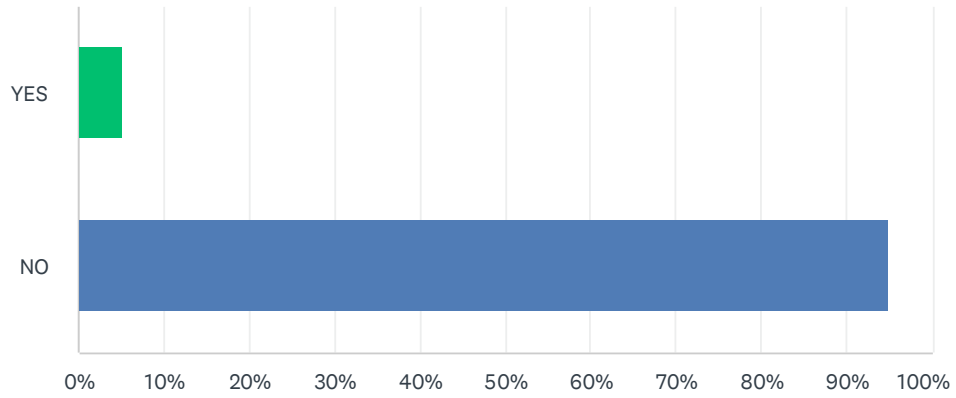
